1. Where’s your \_\_\_\_\_

- ⊙ <sup>21</sup> *For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.*
- ⊙ Why not store up treasures here?
- ⊙ Nothing \_\_\_\_\_
- ⊙ Nothing \_\_\_\_\_ for very long
- ⊙ Why store up treasures in heaven?
- ⊙ It lasts \_\_\_\_\_

2. Where’s your \_\_\_\_\_

- ⊙ *“The eye is the lamp of the body.*
- ⊙ *If your eyes are healthy,*
- ⊙ *your whole body will be full of \_\_\_\_\_*
- ⊙ *But if your eyes are unhealthy,*

Money vs. God

- ⊙ *For \_\_\_\_\_ is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.*
  - 1 Timothy 6:10
