2 CORINTHIANS 6, NIV

- •As God's co-workers we urge you not to receive God's grace in vain.² For he says,
- o"In the time of my favor I heard you,
 - and in the day of salvation I helped you."
- •I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation.

o³We put no stumbling block in anyone's path, so that our ministry will not be discredited. ⁴ Rather, as servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: in great endurance; in troubles, hardships and distresses;⁵ in beatings, imprisonments and riots; in hard work, sleepless nights and hunger;

^o⁶ in purity, understanding, patience and kindness; in the Holy Spirit and in sincere love; ⁷ in truthful speech and in the power of God; with weapons of righteousness in the right hand and in the left;⁸ through glory and dishonor, bad report and good report; genuine, yet regarded as impostors;

•⁹ known, yet regarded as unknown; dying, and yet we live on; beaten, and yet not killed; ¹⁰ sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; poor, yet making many rich; having nothing, and yet possessing everything. $^{\circ}$ ¹¹We have spoken freely to you, Corinthians, and opened wide our hearts to you. ¹²We are not withholding our affection from you, but you are withholding yours from us. ¹³As a fair exchange—I speak as to my children—open wide your hearts also.

O¹⁴ **Do not be yoked together with** unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness? ¹⁵ What harmony is there between Christ and Belial^[b]? Or what does a believer have in common with an unbeliever?

^{o¹⁶What agreement is there} between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: o"I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people."

¹⁷ Therefore,
"Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you."

¹⁸ And, "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."
