#### 2 Corinthians 9, NIV

\* There is no need for me to write to you about this service to the Lord's people.<sup>2</sup> For I know your eagerness to help, and I have been boasting about it to the Macedonians, telling them that since last year you in Achaia were ready to give; and your enthusiasm has stirred most of them to action.

\* <sup>3</sup> But I am sending the brothers in order that our boasting about you in this matter should not prove hollow, but that you may be ready, as I said you would be. <sup>4</sup> For if any Macedonians come with me and find you unprepared, we—not to say anything about you—would be ashamed of having been so confident.

#### \* <sup>5</sup> So I thought it necessary to urge the brothers to visit you in advance and finish the arrangements for the generous gift you had promised. Then it will be ready as a generous gift, not as one grudgingly given.

\* <sup>6</sup> Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. <sup>7</sup> Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

- \* <sup>8</sup> And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. <sup>9</sup> As it is written:
- \* "They have freely scattered their gifts to the poor; their righteousness endures forever."

\* <sup>10</sup> Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.<sup>11</sup> You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

\* <sup>12</sup> This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of the Lord's people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God. <sup>13</sup> Because of the service by which you have proved yourselves, others will praise God for the obedience that accompanies your confession of the gospel of Christ,

\* and for your generosity in sharing with them and with everyone else. <sup>14</sup> And in their prayers for you their hearts will go out to you, because of the surpassing grace God has given you. <sup>15</sup> Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!

#### 1. Eagerness & Enthusiasm

- \* <sup>2</sup> For I know your <u>eagerness</u> to help, ... and your <u>enthusiasm</u> has stirred most of them to action.
- \* How would someone <u>describe you?</u>
- \* How do these characteristics give glory to God?
- \* They demonstrate genuine faith

#### 2. Life Principle: Sow = <u>Reap</u>

- \* <sup>6</sup> Remember this:
- Whoever sows <u>sparingly</u> will also reap <u>sparingly</u>,
- \* and whoever sows <u>generously</u> will also reap <u>generously</u>.
- \* Who is the most generous?
- \* 'You can't <u>out give God'</u>

#### 3. God loves what?

\* <sup>7</sup> Each of you should give what you have <u>decided in your heart</u> to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion,
\* for God loves a <u>cheerful giver.</u>

#### 4. God's blessing = <u>ALL</u>

- \* <sup>8</sup> And God is able to bless you abundantly,
- \* so that in <u>all things</u> at <u>all times</u>,
- \* having <u>all</u> that you <u>need</u>,
- \* you will abound in every good work.

5. Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!

- \* <sup>15</sup> <u>Thanks</u> be to God for his indescribable gift!
- \* What is the best gift you have ever received?
- \* Not always the <u>size or value</u>
