- <sup>2</sup> Grace and peace be yours in abundance through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.

His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. 4 Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature, having escaped the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

■ <sup>5</sup> For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; <sup>6</sup> and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; <sup>7</sup> and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love.

For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup> But whoever does not have them is nearsighted and blind, forgetting that they have been cleansed from their past sins.

## AND, IT'S BEEN TESTED AND PROVEN RELIABLE!

- One Example: availability of ancient manuscripts:
- The quantity of New Testament manuscripts is unparalleled in ancient literature. There are over <u>5,000</u> Greek manuscripts, about <u>8,000</u> Latin manuscripts, and another <u>1,000</u> manuscripts in other languages (Syriac, Coptic, etc.).

- In addition to this extraordinary number, there are tens of thousands of citations of New Testament passages by the early church fathers. In contrast, the typical number of existing manuscript copies for any of the works of the Greek and Latin authors, such as Plato, Aristotle, Caesar, or Tacitus, ranges from one to 20.

## 2.HELPWITH: WORK

- Colossians 3:23: Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters,...
- I Timothy 5.8 But if anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an <u>unbeliever</u>.

## 3.HELPWITH: **EMOTIONS**

- FEAR: good fear or bad fear?
- Good fear: Proverbs 19:23: The fear of the LORD leads to <u>life</u>, and whoever has it <u>rests satisfied</u>; he will not be visited by harm.

### HELPWITH: EMOTIONS

- Bad Fear: 2 Timothy 1:7: for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of <u>power</u> and <u>love</u> and <u>self-control</u>.
- ANGER: Ephesians 4.26 "In your anger do not <u>sin"</u>:
  Do not let <u>the sun go down</u> while you are still angry,
- 27 and do not give the devil a foothold.

## 4.HELP WITH: BEHAVIOR: SELF-CONTROL

For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live <u>self-controlled, upright</u> and <u>godly lives</u> in this present age, while we wait for the blessed hope—

• the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, <sup>14</sup> who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good.
