John McArthur – *false disciples*

- 1. false disciples are attracted by the crowd.
- 2. false followers are fascinated by the supernatural
- 3. they think only of *earthly benefits*
- 4. the false disciple has no desire for worship

Where you have a church of 75 people in a little building, people who pray together and love the Lord and worship, and sing hymns and somebody gets up and teaches the Word of God, they're not going to draw that crowd.

The Good:

They're not going to draw that crowd because the only thing that would draw them would be the love of the *Lord*, the love of the *Word*, and the love of *God's people*
