SOTM Lesson 8: *PRAY!*Matthew 6.1-18, NIV

- "Be careful not to practice your righteousness in front of others to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven.
- 2 "So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full.

• ³ But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, ⁴ so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

• 5 "And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. ⁶ But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen.

• Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you. ⁷ And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. ⁸ Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

- 9 "This, then, is how you should pray:
- "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, ¹⁰ your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

- ¹¹ Give us today our daily bread.
 - ¹² And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
 - ¹³ And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.'

• ¹⁴ For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. ¹⁵ But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

• 16 "When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full.

• ¹⁷ But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, ¹⁸ so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

John Piper:

• "Hallowed be thy name" is a request, not a declaration. We are not saying, "Lord, your name *is* hallowed!" We are saying, "Lord, cause your name to be hallowed!" That is, cause your word to be *believed*, cause your displeasure to be *feared*, cause your commandments to be *obeyed*, and cause yourself to be *glorified*. You hallow the name of God when you trust him, revere him, obey him, and glorify him.
