Lesson 7: The Power of Prayer

- Actually, the power of God released through prayer!
- We need help in our praying
- We need to know that God hears and answers us
- But . . .
- What if He doesn't?

I.When to pray - Phil. 4

 4 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! ⁵ Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. 6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Prelude to Praying:

- Rejoice in the Lord <u>always</u>.
- I will say it again: Rejoice!
- 5 Let your **gentleness** be evident to all.
- The Lord is <u>near</u>.

The Command to Pray:

- 6 Do not be anxious about anything,
- but in <u>every situation</u>,
- by <u>prayer</u> and petition,
- with thanksgiving,
- present your requests to God.

The **Promise**:

- And the <u>peace</u> of God, which transcends all understanding,
- will guard
- your <u>hearts</u> and your <u>minds</u>
- in **Christ Jesus.**

2. Pray According to God's Will

 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life. 14 This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. 15 And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him. 1 John 5

First things first:

- ¹³ I write these things to you who <u>believe</u> in the name of the Son of God so that you may <u>know</u> that you have <u>eternal life</u>.

Confidence in the Almighty:

- ¹⁴ This is the <u>confidence</u> we have in approaching God:
- that if we ask anything according to <u>his</u>
 will, he <u>hears us.</u>
- ¹⁵ And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that <u>we</u> have what we asked of him. 1 John 5

But .. There is the waiting

- And it will be said in that day:
 "Behold, this is our God;
- We have <u>waited for Him</u>, and He will save us.
- This is the LORD;
- We have <u>waited for Him</u>;
- We will be glad and rejoice in His salvation." Isaiah 25.9, NKJV

Keep at it - persevere

- Then He spoke a parable to them, that men <u>always ought to pray</u> and not lose <u>heart,</u> ² saying: . .
- Read it tonight! Luke 18
- ¹⁶ Rejoice always, ¹⁷ **pray without ceasing**, ¹⁸ in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. *1 Thess. 5*
