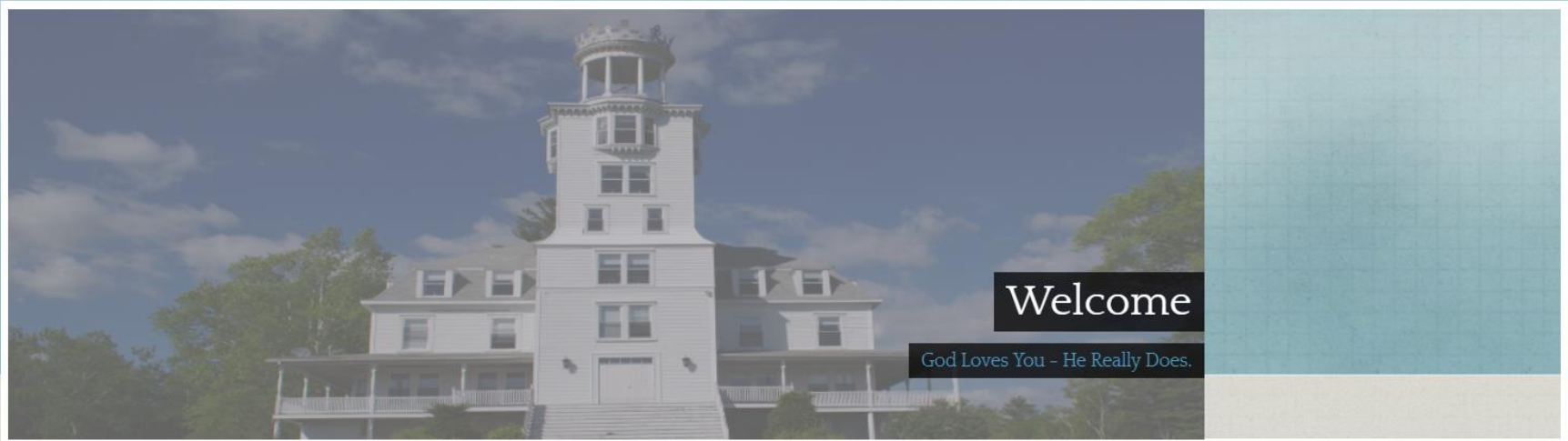

o 5 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.

o James 1

Why wisdom?

- o So many decisions in life . .
- o Right from wrong
- o Financial decisions
- o Relationship issues
- o Time management
- o Health care

True Wisdom:

- Wisdom begins and ends with **the fear of the Lord**. It isn't a fear of being struck by lightning or fear of being struck dead but it's a deep, abiding, holy **reverence and respect** for the Lord and for His Word, the Bible.

o The ultimate manifestation of wisdom was (and is) Jesus Christ. Ultimately God revealed his wisdom in the person of his own Son, Jesus Christ.

THE KEY:

o ¹⁰ “The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom,
And the knowledge of the Holy One *is* understanding.

o Proverbs 9, NKJV

- o ¹⁵ The simple believe anything,
but the prudent give thought to
their steps.
- o ¹⁶ The wise fear the LORD and shun
evil,
but a fool is hotheaded and yet
feels secure.

The promise again:

Jesus = Wisdom

- o 2 My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, **Christ,**
- o 3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of **wisdom and knowledge.**
 - o Colossians 2

Wisdom's 'qualities'

o **17** But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all *pure*; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of *mercy* and good fruit, impartial and *sincere*.

o James 3

Wise vs Foolish

- ²⁴ “Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock.

o ²⁶ But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. ²⁷ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.”

o Matthew 7

Paul's Prayer:

o⁹ For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives,

o ¹⁰ so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, ¹¹ being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience,

o ¹² and giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light.
