Faith & HOPE

Now faith is confidence in what we <u>hope for</u> and assurance about what we do not see.

Hebrews 11.1, NIV

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. NASB

- oWhat is faith? It is the confident assurance that something we want is going to happen. It is the <u>certainty</u> that what we <u>hope for</u> is waiting for us, even though we cannot see it up ahead.

 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God.

o³ Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; ⁴ perseverance, character; and character, <u>hope.</u>

o⁵ And hope does not put us to shame (or disappoint), because <u>God's love</u> has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

2 Corinthians 1, NIV

o⁸ We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about the troubles we experienced in the province of Asia. We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired of life itself.

o⁹ Indeed, we felt we had received the sentence of death. But this happened that we might not rely on ourselves but on God, who raises the dead. 10 He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us again.

oOn him we have set our hope that he will continue to deliver us, ¹¹ as you help us by your prayers. Then many will give thanks on our behalf for the gracious favor granted us in answer to the prayers of many.
