- Stay the course" is a phrase used in the context of a war or battle meaning to pursue a goal regardless of any obstacles or criticism.

1 Timothy 1, NIV: Lesson 1: What We Really Need!

- Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the command of God our Savior and of Christ Jesus our hope,
- ² To Timothy my true son in the faith:
- Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

• 3 As I urged you when I went into Macedonia, stay there in Ephesus so that you may command certain people not to teach false doctrines any longer 4 or to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies. Such things promote controversial speculations rather than advancing God's work—which is by faith.

 ⁵ The goal of this command is love, which comes from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith. ⁶ Some have departed from these and have turned to meaningless talk. ⁷ They want to be teachers of the law, but they do not know what they are talking about or what they so confidently affirm.

2. The Big 3:

- ² To Timothy my true son in the faith:
- Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Timothy needed these 3 –
- Don't you?
- Know anyone else who does?

GRACE:

Grace is what God does for us who are so <u>undeserving</u>; we are not entitled to His forgiving love and His incredible kindness, nor cab we earn His favor – it is unmerited, and we could never repay Him for the honor of being accepted by Him.

MERCY:

- Mercy The best definition I've heard for 'mercy' is this:
- "God's ministry to the <u>miserable</u>"

PEACE:

- The gift of 'peace' is the experience of an inner calm, an unshakable tranquility that settles in at the core of a person's life, even though things all around may be wild and woolly. There is a peace only the Christian can know – because it is based on peace with God
