1. The Bible reveals Who God is

In the beginning, God ...
Genesis 1.1
I am the LORD, and there is no other; Isaiah 45.5, NIV

2. The Bible defines who we are

Simply put, sinners, i.e., separated from God:

 All we like sheep have gone astray;
 We have turned, every one, to his own way; Isaiah 53.6, NKJV The Bible declares our problem: sin Diversal No exceptions all humanity For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God – Romans 3.23, NIV

3. Explains the meaning and purpose of life:

¹³ That's the whole story. Here now is my final conclusion:

Fear God and obey his commands, for this is everyone's duty.

Ecclesiastes 12:13, New Living Translation

5. Points us to our only Hope: Jesus

Jesus is still rescuing people! >²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, >²⁴ and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. Romans 3.23-24, NIV

But discouragement is still around : The prophet Jeremiah could have been discouraged: He obeyed God to prophesy, but no one listened He saw war, captivity, the destruction of the temple and Jerusalem

But even Jeremiah found HOPE!

 Yet this I call to mind and therefore I have hope:
 ²² Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
 ²⁴ I say to myself, "The LORD is my portion; therefore I will wait for him."

The LORD is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him; ²⁶ it is good to wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD. **Lamentations 3.21-26, NIV**

The world is still under God's control:

All the peoples of the earth are regarded as nothing. He does as he pleases with the powers of heaven and the peoples of the earth. No one can hold back his hand or say to him: "What have you done?"

Daniel 4.35, NIV

Don't worry, be happy!

⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
