# God Creates a New World

**17 “For behold, I create new heavens  
and a new earth;**

**And the former things will not be  
remembered or come to mind. 18 But  
be glad and rejoice forever in what I  
create;**

**For behold, I create Jerusalem for  
rejoicing**

**And her people for gladness.**

# God Creates a New World

**19 I will also rejoice in Jerusalem  
and be glad in My people;**

**And there will no longer be heard in  
her**

**The voice of weeping and the sound  
of crying.**

# God Creates a New World

**20 No longer will there be in it an infant  
who lives only a few days,  
Or an old person who does not live out  
his days;  
For the youth will die at the age of a  
hundred,  
And the one who does not reach the  
age of a hundred  
Will be thought accursed.**

# God Creates a New World

**21 They will build houses and inhabit them;  
They will also plant vineyards and eat their  
fruit.**

**22 They will not build and another inhabit,  
They will not plant and another eat;  
For as the lifetime of a tree, so will be the  
days of My people,**

**And My chosen ones will fully enjoy the work  
of their hands.**

**23 They will not labor in vain,  
Or give birth to children for  
disaster;**

**For they are the descendants of  
those blessed by the Lord,  
And their descendants with them.**

# God Creates a New World

**24 It will also come to pass that before they call, I will answer; while they are still speaking, I will listen. 25 The wolf and the lamb will graze together, and the lion will eat straw like the ox; and dust will be the serpent's food. They will do no evil or harm on all My holy mountain," says the Lord.**

**18 "For I know their works and their thoughts; the time is coming to gather all the nations and tongues. And they shall come and see My glory.**

# God Gathers a New People

**19 And I will put a sign among them and send survivors from them to the nations: Tarshish, Put, Lud, Meshech, Tubal, and Javan, to the distant coastlands that have neither heard of My fame nor seen My glory. And they will declare My glory among the nations.**

# God Gathers a New People

20 Then they shall bring all your countrymen from all the nations as a grain offering to the Lord, on horses, in chariots, in litters, on mules, and on camels, to My holy mountain Jerusalem," says the Lord, "just as the sons of Israel bring their grain offering in a clean vessel to the house of the Lord. 21 I will also take some of them as priests and Levites," says the Lord.

# God Establishes a New Worship Forever


**24 “Then they will go out and look
