# Sudden Salvation

**7 “Before she was in labor, she delivered;  
Before her pain came, she gave birth to a  
boy.**

**8 Who has heard such a thing? Who has  
seen such things?**

**Can a land be born in one day?**

**Can a nation be given birth all at once?**

**As soon as Zion was in labor, she also  
delivered her sons.**

**Isaiah 66:7-8 (NASB)**



# N.T. Witness (New Birth)

**“unless someone is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.””**

**John 3:3**

**18 In the exercise of His will He gave us birth by the word of truth,...**

# N.T. Witness (New Birth)

**4 But God, being rich in mercy,  
because of His great love with  
which He loved us, 5 even when we  
were dead in our wrongdoings,  
made us alive together with Christ  
(by grace you have been saved),  
Ephesians 2:4-5**

# Deep Comfort

**10 “Be joyful with Jerusalem and rejoice for her, all you who love her; Be exceedingly glad with her, all you who mourn over her,**

**11 So that you may nurse and be satisfied with her comforting breasts, So that you may drink fully and be delighted with her bountiful breasts.”**

**Isaiah 66:10-11 (NASB)**



# God of Comfort

**3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, 4 who comforts us in all our affliction so that we will be able to comfort those who are in any affliction with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.**

**2 Corinthians 1:3-4 (NASB)**



# Deep Comfort

**12 For this is what the Lord says:  
“Behold, I extend peace to her like a  
river,**

**And the glory of the nations like an  
overflowing stream;**

**And you will be nursed; you will be  
carried on the hip and rocked back and  
forth on the knees.**

**Isaiah 66:12 (NASB)**



# Christ's Peace

**27 Peace I leave you, My peace I give you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, nor fearful.**

# Deep Comfort

**13 As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you; And you will be comforted in Jerusalem."**

**Isaiah 66:13 (NASB)**



# Final Comfort

**4 and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away."**

**Revelation 21:4 (NASB)**



# Comfort for His Servants

**14 Then you will see this, and your heart will be glad,**

**And your bones will flourish like the new grass;**

**And the hand of the Lord will be made known to His servants,**

**But He will be indignant toward His enemies.**

**Isaiah 66:14 (NASB)**



# Final Judgement

**15 For behold, the Lord will come in fire,**

**And His chariots like the whirlwind,**

**To render His anger with fury,**

**And His rebuke with flames of fire.**

**Isaiah 66:15 (NASB)**



# Final Judgement

**16 For the Lord will execute  
judgment by fire**

**And by His sword on humanity,**

**And those put to death by the Lord  
will be many.**

**Isaiah 66:16 (NASB)**



# Judgement Fulfilled

**7 and to give relief to you who are afflicted, along with us, when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels 8 in flaming fire, dealing out retribution to those who do not know God, and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 9 These people will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power,**

**2 Thessalonians 1:7-9 (NASB)**



# Judgement Fulfilled

**14 And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, were following Him on white horses. 15 From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.**

# Final Judgement

**17 “Those who sanctify and purify themselves to go to the gardens,  
Following one in the center,  
Who eat pig’s flesh, detestable things, and mice,  
Will come to an end altogether,”  
declares the Lord.**

# Final Separation

**31 "But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. 32 And all the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, just as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats;**
