1 The record of the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham:

2 Abraham fathered Isaac, Isaac fathered Jacob, and Jacob fathered Judah and his brothers.

3 Judah fathered Perez and Zerah by Tamar, Perez fathered Hezron, and Hezron fathered Ram.

fathered Solomon by her who had been
the wife of Uriah.**

Rehoboam fathered Abijah, and
Abijah fathered Asa.**

**8 Asa fathered Jehoshaphat,
Jehoshaphat fathered Joram, and
Joram fathered Uzziah.**

**9 Uzziah fathered Jotham, Jotham
fathered Ahaz, and Ahaz fathered
Hezekiah.**

**10 Hezekiah fathered Manasseh,
Manasseh fathered Amon, and Amon
fathered Josiah.**

**11 Josiah fathered Jeconiah and his
brothers, at the time of the
deportation to Babylon.**

**12 After the deportation to Babylon:
Jeconiah fathered Shealtiel, and
Shealtiel fathered Zerubbabel.**

**13 Zerubbabel fathered Abihud, Abihud
fathered Eliakim, and Eliakim fathered
Azor.**

**14 Azor fathered Zadok, Zadok fathered
Achim, and Achim fathered Eliud.**

15 Eliud fathered Eleazar, Eleazar fathered Matthan, and Matthan fathered Jacob.

16 Jacob fathered Joseph the husband of Mary, by whom Jesus was born, who is called the Messiah.

The Son of David

12 When your days are finished and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your descendant after you, who will come from you, and I will establish his kingdom.

13 He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

The Son of David

The Son of Abraham

Why the Exile Came
